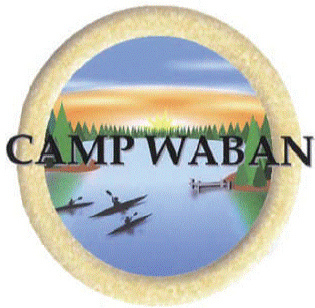
Four season facilities for recreation, therapy, and experiential learning.



Your clients will benefit from and enjoy a day or overnight trip to Camp Waban. While at Camp Waban campers will enjoy:



- ◆ A fully accessible waterfront with beach wheelchairs so everyone can enjoy the waterfront, swimming and boating together.
- ◆ A fully accessible bathhouse with changing area, showers, and bathrooms adjacent to the waterfront.
- ◆ Pontoon boat rides around the lake which often have a calming effect on many individuals, and see ducks, loons, turtles, and other aquatic animals.
- ◆ Rides on the pontoon boat, which is accessible to all and has a capacity of 18 riders.
- ◆ Swings, climbing structures, playground equipment, and slides provide recreation and sensory opportunities for campers.
- ◆ A fully accessible dock for fishing and fishing license which covers anyone with a disabilities. Campers have enjoyed catching bass, perch, and sunfish have been caught in the lake.
- ◆ Kayaks, paddle boats, and row boats can be taken around the lake for fun or as physical or occupational therapy for campers.
- ◆ Lifeguards ensuring swimming sessions safe on a daily basis.
- ◆ Sporting equipment that is always available to play basketball, wiffleball, tetherball, badminton, soccer, horseshoes, and volleyball.
- ◆ Universally accessible hiking and walking trails that bring campers through forests and wetlands providing opportunities for nature exploration.
- ◆ Snowshoeing and facilitated challenge element activities
- ◆ Home cooked meals and snacks provided for our overnight campers
- ◆ A fire pit by the water for day, evening, and night time campfires.
